Welcome to Year 10! Each Year Group has a Senior Link assigned to oversee them and I am the link for Year 10. Year 10 marks an exciting transition from KS3 to KS4. Students continue with their core subjects of course, but also experience the privilege of spending more time on subjects of their choosing. They are no longer assessed using our descriptors of Emerging, Developing, etc. instead use GCSE grades or Pass/Merit/Distinction. The Minimum Target Grades have been set and the two-year GCSE and vocational courses begin. Indeed, studies begin to feel more serious, but this comes at a time when students crave the additional vigour and responsibility that comes with these demanding level 2 qualifications. Students can also look forward to additional extracurricular opportunities: they can join the Duke of Edinburgh scheme and just for this year choose between a one week work experience placement or a residential trip.

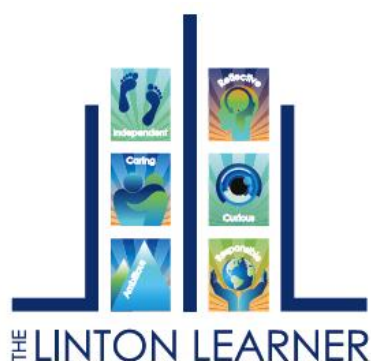
