Welcome to Year 7! The pastoral structure at the College comprises of a House system. There are four Houses: Discovery; Endeavour; Pioneer and Voyager. Students at the College decided on the names of our Houses - all of which are named after space probes or rockets/spaceships. Each House has a Head and Deputy Head of House (please see above). Heads of House are line managed by members of the Senior Leadership Team: Discovery and Pioneer are overseen by Shahla Matarazzo, Deputy Principal and Endeavour and Voyager are overseen by George Jenkins, Assistant Principal. As well as House identity, we realise that belonging to a year group is also very important therefore each year group has a senior leader as a link. Mrs Garner worked very closely with me throughout the transition process therefore is ideal to continue with our youngest students and their families.
