

Dear Parent/Carer

Cases in schools across Cambridgeshire have almost doubled in the last two weeks and this includes a few cases of the Omicron variant. I am pleased to say that our cases appear to have stabilised, with very few new cases identified over the weekend. This is following an increase to 75% in the number of reported results on ALISS.

The current figures are below: 37 positive PCR results & 11 awaiting...

- Year 7 26 positive PCR and 4 suspected cases. There are additional measures in place for Year 7 to reduce the risks to other Year groups.
- Year 8
 Year 9
 Year 10
 4 positive PCR and 2 suspected cases
 5 positive PCR and 1 suspected case
 1 positive PCR and 1 suspected case
- Year 11 2 suspected cases
- Staff 1 positive PCR and 1 suspected case.

Please do continue to carry out the twice weekly LFTs and record the results using the link to ALISS. If you notify us that you are taking your child for a PCR test, please can ensure you forward on the confirmation of the result to attendance@lvc.org.

Following the emergence of the Omicron variant the guidance regarding self-isolation is changing and we are awaiting clarification from the Local Authority about this. In the meantime, please do continue to book PCR tests if your child has a positive LFT or is showing one of the three main Covid symptoms.
