



Dear Parent/Carer

Following last week's announcement that the minimum isolation period has been reduced again I thought it would be helpful to clarify what this means. Please remember that the date of the symptoms starting or the positive LFT, if asymptomatic, is day zero. To help us ensure that our registers are correct we ask that you record the LFT result on the [NHS website here](#), as well as recording the result on ALIS, and forward the email you receive to [attendance@lvc.org](mailto:attendance@lvc.org).

It is important to remember that in order to reduce the isolation period your child must not have a temperature. If they test negative on day five, then they may carry out another test on day six which, if negative, means they may return to school that day; please make sure that you leave enough time to test your child, log the result and forward the NHS email to us. To help us keep track of those returning early we ask that you forward all negative LFT confirmation emails from the NHS to [attendance@lvc.org](mailto:attendance@lvc.org).

Hopefully the attached document, produced by the Local Authority, will address any questions you may have regarding this issue.
