Testing & Reporting

We continue to see new asymptomatic cases being picked up through the regular twice-weekly LFTs. Despite the shorter self-isolation periods this means we are still seeing a steady rise in the overall cases. Please can I remind everyone to conduct these tests. Only 64% were recorded on ALIS this weekend. Please remember that positive results should also be recorded on the NHS website here. For those who test positive it is important that any negative LFT results from day 5 onwards are also recorded on the NHS website here (please see here for guidance on the new isolation periods).
