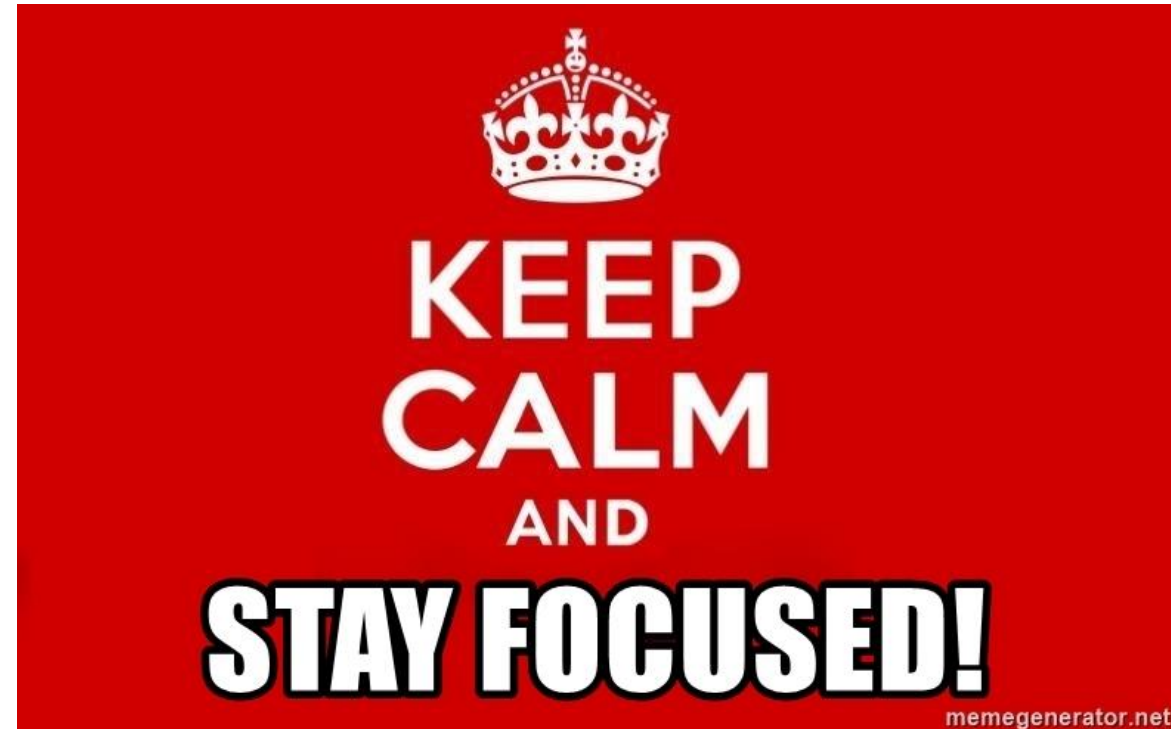

- After school and lunch time sessions to support you.



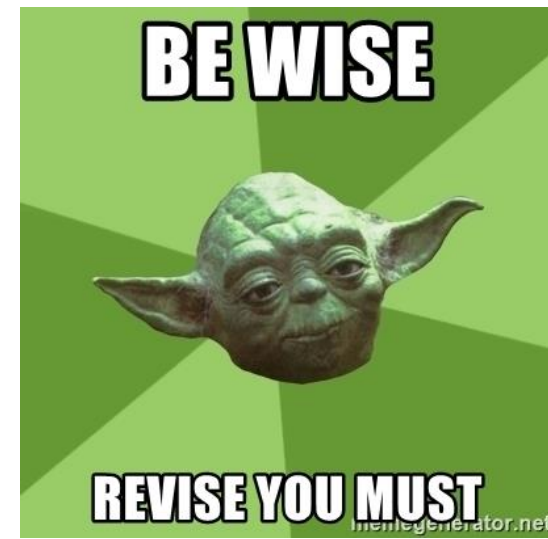
2) Final day of lessons on Friday 13th May.

5) Easter and half-term

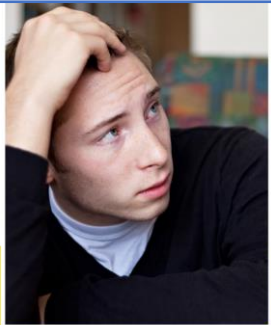
- Incredible opportunities for independent revision

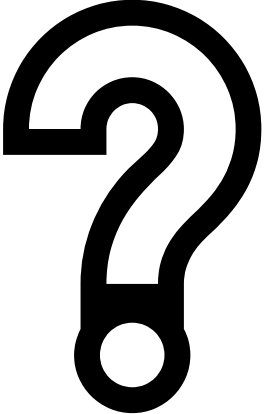
- Exams are going ahead.
