In this unit, pupils will research health promotion campaigns and learn about their benefits to society. Pupils will also plan and deliver their own health promotion campaign. Topics include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current public health issues and the impact on society. • Factors influencing health. • Plan and create a health promotion campaign. • Deliver and evaluate a health promotion campaign.

This qualification will allow pupils to explore different areas of the health and social care provision in the UK.

The three components studied - principles of care, supporting individuals through life events and health promotion campaigns - allow pupils to explore their interests in human development and health and wellbeing across a range of life stages and life experiences.
