



Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you for your understanding with our decision to close the school today due to adverse weather conditions.

The site team has worked hard today, with support from Cam Grain, to clear the drive and paths on site and to spread salt to make the school ready to reopen tomorrow.

Given the icy conditions that are forecast overnight, we are planning a later start of 9.30am tomorrow morning. This will allow more time for staff and buses to travel into school safely.

This has been arranged with bus companies with the Andrews bus (LIN01 from Haverhill) being the only exception.

- If your child catches a school bus other than the Andrews LIN01 they should catch it an hour later than usual.
- If your child walks or gets a lift to school, please make arrangements for them to arrive at school from 9.20-9.30am.
- If your child catches the Andrews LIN01 bus they should catch it at the usual time and head straight to the school hall on arrival where they will be supervised until the timetable starts at 9.30am.

At 9.30am, students will have form time for 20 minutes in their tutor bases (Year 10 will line up for assembly). They will then head to Period 2 and break as usual. They will need to pack for Periods 2-5, missing Period 1.

If circumstances change overnight or staffing levels become compromised, I'll be in touch as early as possible in the morning with further updates. Otherwise, we look forward to seeing everyone back in school in the morning.

Please make sure that you child is dressed warmly and has a change of footwear, should they need it.
