Out of catchment bus service

We are hoping to continue with the bus service that we currently arrange. To ensure that we can proceed in organising the bus provision for the new academic year starting September 2024 we need know if you would still like to continue with this service.

The cost for the Suffolk service in the current year is £735 per student, which equates to £18.84 per week. Please note this cost is subject to change for September 2024. The College pay the bus company at the start of the year and offer you the ability to pay in instalments over the school year.
