## **Top Tips for MFL Revision**

1. Make the most of lessons

Teachers are your best resources! You have some very competent language experts teaching you; they have planned and created lessons targeted to your needs. Make sure you make notes, ask questions and participate.



2. Use LanguageNut and Seneca to revise vocabulary sets and grammar + BBC Bitesize to get some exam questions.



3. Spend sometime watching a French/Spanish film! (recommended platforms: Netflix, Amazon Prime, Apple TV ...)

Challenge yourself by turning the subtitles in French/Spanish so you hear the words and see the spelling at the same time. Don't worry if you don't understand everything, it's all about being exposed to the language!



4. Complete past papers on AQA website and mark according to the mark scheme
