Dear Parents and Carers,

Our enrichment week is fast approaching, and we hope that your child is looking forward to this week. Please find below the final arrangements for the week which includes the groupings on the days when the year group is divided.

Year 7 Enrichment Week

Monday 9 June

We will be in school; students will be attending workshops which are all based around the cultural theme of a Cuban Day. These workshops will include learning how to play Cuban style music and creating a dance piece with Flawless Dance Company's Oddey.

Students will need to be in school PE kit and can wear trainers. Normal break and lunchtime arrangements will be in place.

Tuesday and Wednesday 10th and 11th June:

The year group will be divided in half for these two days (please see groupings below).

We will be visiting 'Wild forest' to complete an obstacle course for one day, developing confidence and teamwork.

We will be leaving the college at 8.30am and returning for the school buses.

Students need to be in comfortable clothing that they do not mind getting wet/dirty. They should bring a snack, packed lunch, a towel, and clothes to change into, plus a bag for wet/muddy clothes and trainers.

The other half of the year group will be visiting Cambridge as part of a cultural day. Activities will include visiting places of cultural interest including a Cambridge University Museum and also a tour of Cambridge architecture by punt. Year 7 students will be writing about this day as part of their Arts Award Bronze.

Students need to be in full uniform with comfortable footwear for walking. Students will need a packed lunch for this day. There may be some opportunity to purchase an ice cream and therefore students may wish to bring a small amount of money. Students will return in time for the buses.

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IMPORTANT for all days:

Packed Lunches – Cannot include nuts or chewing gum. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals they will be provided with a packed lunch from school. .

Mobile Phones - For all trips out of school, students are allowed to take their mobile phones, but they must not use them to go on social media sites or to take photos of other students without their permission. Students are responsible for their own phones and any loss or damage will not be covered by our insurance.

Spending money – Students may take a small amount of spending money on days out, no more than £10; however, staff cannot take responsibility for this.

Clothing expectations – These have been added to each day, please also ensure students are weather ready with plenty of sunscreen, waterproof clothing and water to stay hydrated throughout the week.

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DISCIPLINE CODE OF CONDUCT – VISITS

Whilst on a trip or activity off the College premises your child is expected to set a good example and be an ambassador for Linton Village College. Itemised below is the code of conduct that your child is expected to follow.

Where there are concerns around a student's behaviour leading up to the trip or visit, a behaviour support plan will be implemented by Heads of Year in advance of the trip's departure. Students who do not meet the agreed targets about their behaviour will not, for their own safety or safety of others, be included on the visit.

1. Instructions of staff must be obeyed without delay at all times.
2. No inappropriate use of the internet e.g. websites or cyber-bullying.
3. No photographs or videos of people without their permission.
4. Students are not allowed to smoke.
5. Alcoholic drinks are not allowed to be purchased or consumed.
6. Drugs (legal and illegal) are not allowed to be carried, purchased or used.
7. Punctuality is essential. Students must be ready for all programmed activities.
8. Students are expected to be polite and well-mannered at all times.

While travelling by coach or Minibus students should:

- sit on a seat facing the front
- wear their seat belts properly
- not chew gum
- not use the ashtrays
- put any rubbish in the bags provided
- only get out of their seats in an emergency (i.e. feeling ill)
- only use personal devices to listen to music

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
