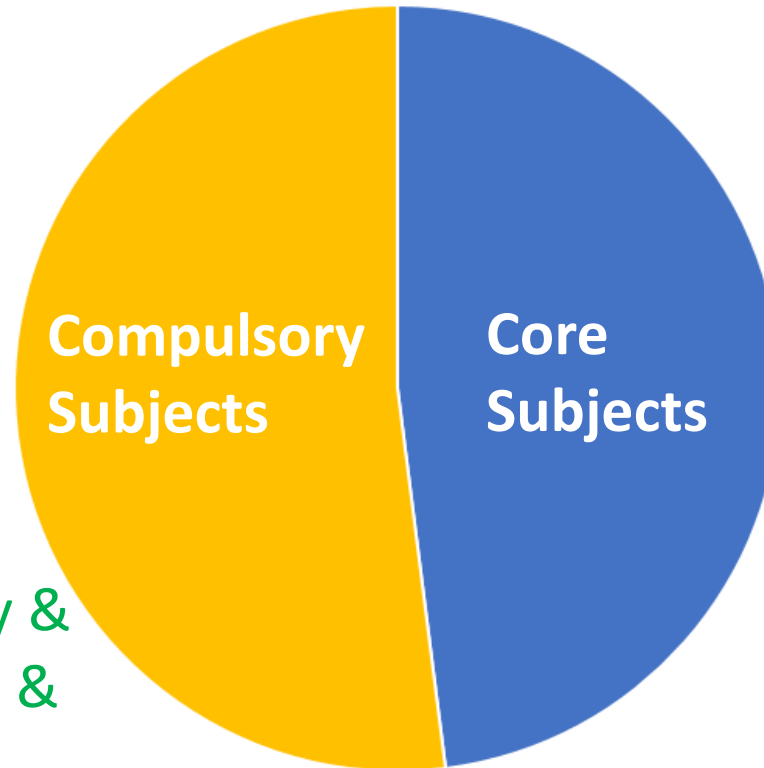

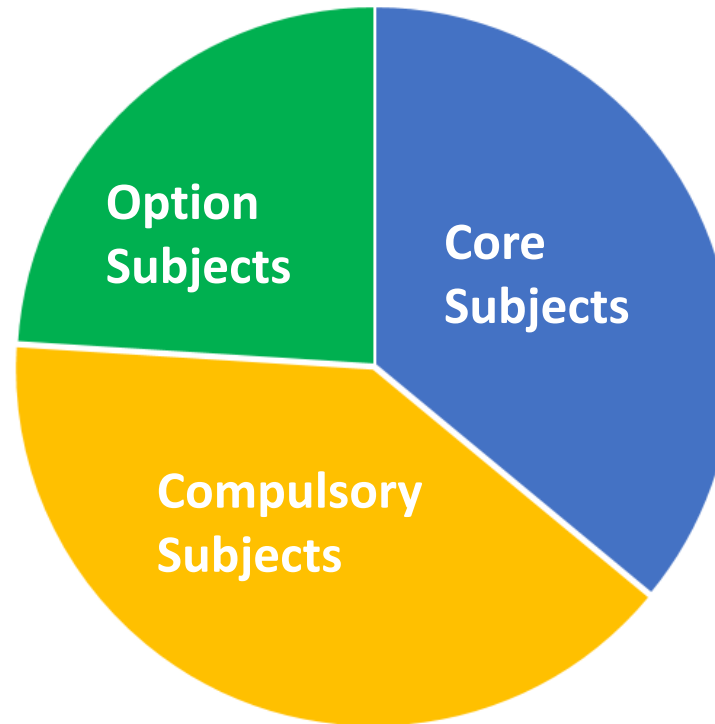
Core Subjects

Options Subjects

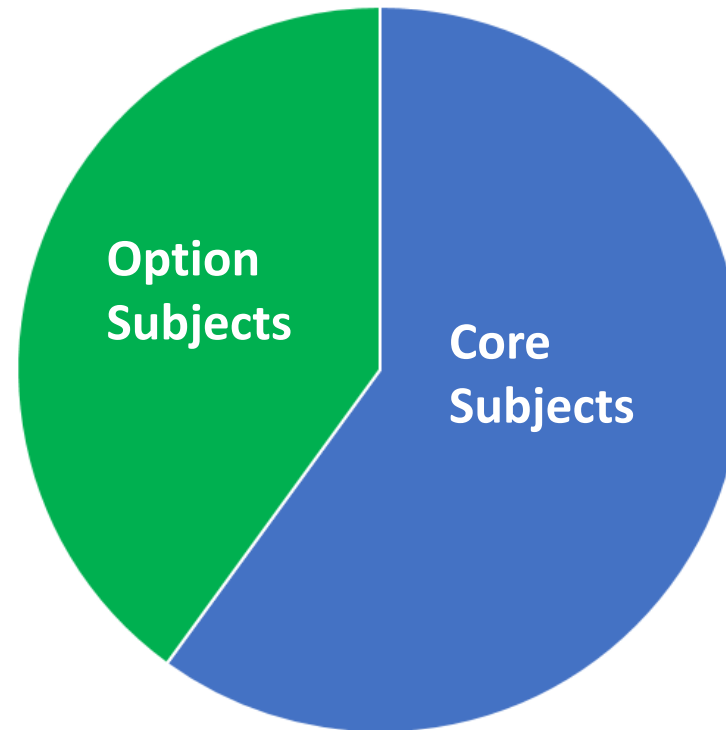
(20 Periods)

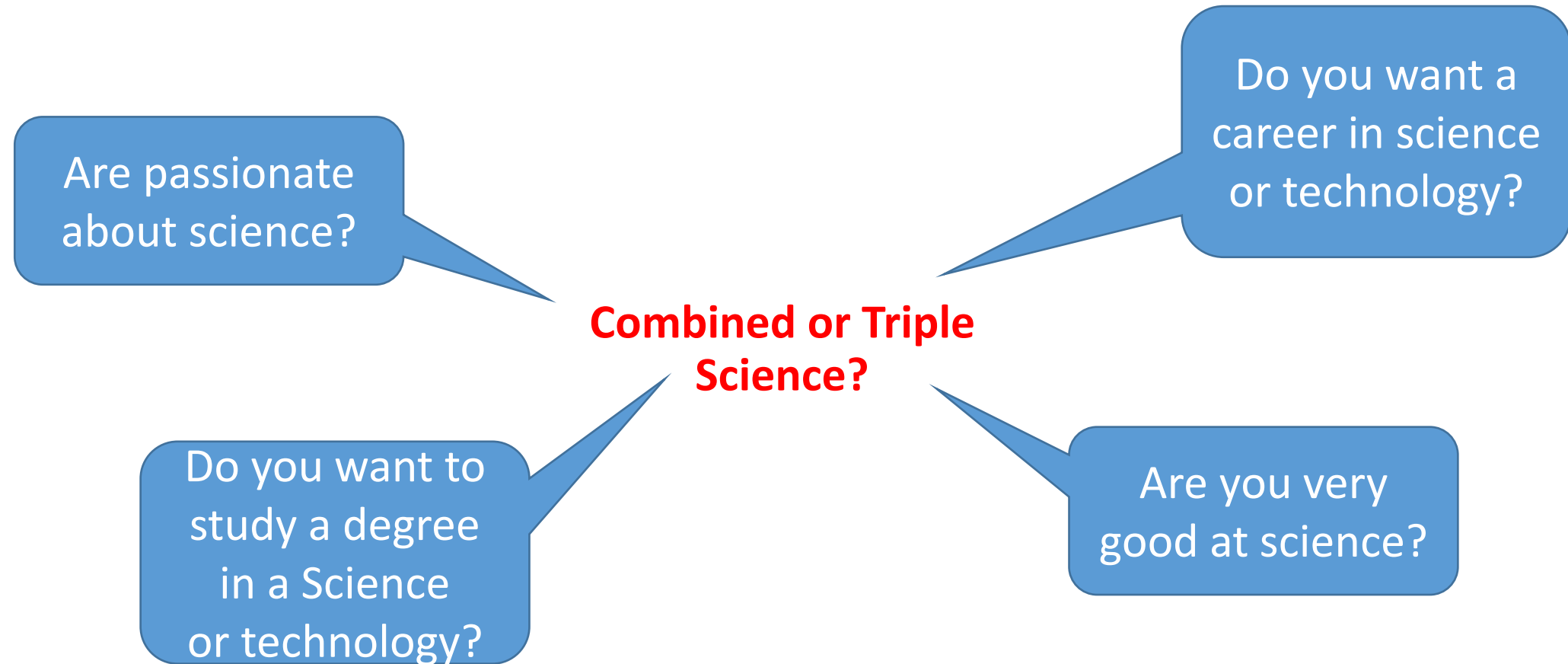
