Complete the Service section of the Bronze Duke of Edinburgh's Award

Introduce a new initiative that encourages diversity, inclusion or respect for others

Complete an accredited training course e.g. first aid, lifeguarding, refereeing, leadership award, Arts Award Silver or Gold, Duke of Edinburgh

Complete a mentoring programme for a younger student for a minimum of a term

Collect 90 Caring house points

Read 5-6 books that challenge your thinking, vocabulary, and interpretation.

Requirements:

- One book over 350 pages
- One classic novel or play
- One book in translation
- One book with a complex or unreliable narrator
- One non-fiction book or memoir
- One book recommended by a peer or teacher

Write a caring letter to someone in the community such as a care home. This will then be followed by a visit to a community setting (please see Mrs Frost to arrange)

Write an article for the Principal's newsletter or local publication

Complete a voluntary project e.g. volunteering for a charity

Lead a club, extra-curricular activity or event in or outside of school

Take an individual lead role within a project e.g. independent project

Represent the school as a leader e.g. leading as part of a sporting event, cultural event, assembly, library event, Senate or directing within an arts event or academic event

Apply and be successful in gaining funding from the Henry Morris Award Scheme

Receive an academic award at a Celebration Evening (this may have been received prior to this award commencing)
